Of course, we'll visit the sites of historic Rome as well, from the Pantheon to Trevi Fountain, the famed Spanish Steps, and more.

We'll travel outside the ancient Roman walls to the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls and the Catacombs, a maze of tunnels hollowed out of volcanic rock where early Christians secretly practiced their religious rites and buried their dead. Our pilgrimage will also take us to Assisi, the place where St. Francis preached the Gospel and where he received the call of the Lord to "Rebuild my Church". Our journey will open for us a treasury of graces made available on this jubilee year of St. Francis of Assisi whenever we visit a site connected to this great saint of the Church.

DAY 1 Sunday, September 27: Depart for Italy

Depart New York JFK International Airport for our overnight flight to Rome, Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board.

DAY 2 Monday, September 28: Welcome to Rome! Visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet our bus driver when exiting Customs. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls for a visit. See where St. Paul is buried in the confessorio of the church. Above his tomb are the chains that were used to imprison him prior to his martyrdom. The main altar in the left transept is dedicated to the conversion of St. Paul. The painting above this altar, completed by Vincenzo Camuccini, depicts this event. Other works of art include the tabernacle of the confessorio by Arnolfo di Cambio, an exquisite 12th-century candelabra by Vassalletto, a 13th-century Byzantine-style apse mosaic of Christ as the Pantokrator, and 19th-century series of papal portraits in a frieze extending around the nave. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Paul.** Independent lunch.

We'll check-in at our hotel in Rome.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (D)

DAY 3 Tuesday, September 29: Assisi | Visit the Sites of St. Francis & St. Clare

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning we will leave Rome for Assisi (3-hour bus ride). Upon arrival, we'll have **Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis.** Independent lunch.

After lunch, we'll visit the basilica complex of St. Francis, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica dates from 1228 to 1230 and is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 to 1253, we will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of the saint. Continue to visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. We'll view her remains and see the basilica's miraculous crucifix. We'll walk to the Sanctuary of the Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major. Pray near the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, the young Catholic from Italy who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. His tomb is in a sanctuary located on the spot where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Continue to visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great basilica built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the Saint died. You will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. After our visit we'll return to Rome. A stop will be made en route to Rome for an independent dinner and refreshments.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

DAY 4 Wednesday, September 30: Papal Audience | Pontifical North American College

After an early breakfast at our hotel, **we will enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Leo XIV will greet the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. End our morning with Mass at the Church of Santo Spirito in Sassia or the Church of Santa Maria in Transpontina. Group lunch at La Vittoria restaurant.** Return to our hotel to freshen up.

Late afternoon, we'll be transferred to the Pontifical North American College for Prayer Vigil at the Chapel.

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,L)

DAY 5 Thursday, October 1: St. Peter's Basilica, Vatican Museums, and Sistine Chapel | Ordination Mass at St. Peter's Basilica

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to one of the great art collections in the world: the Vatican Museums. Walk in the footsteps of the

Princes of the Church through the richly decorated galleries. Continue to the Sistine Chapel, the private chapel of the Popes, where Michelangelo best expressed his genius in monumental frescoes. End at St. Peter's Basilica, and take in the outstanding architecture and the statues adorning the largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pietà." Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. Independent lunch.

We'll be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica to attend the Ordination Mass at the Altar of the Choir of St. Peter's. (Reception at PNAC - subject to confirmation).

Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

DAY 6 Friday, October 2: Papal Basilicas of Rome | Optional Scavi Tour

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (432-440 A.D.). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. View the icon Salus Populi Romani, Protectress of the Roman People, believed to be painted by St. Luke. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major.** Continue to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. The cathedral is known as the "Mater et Caput," the mother and head of all the churches in the entire world, as it officially became the seat of the Bishop of Rome upon the legalization of Christianity under the Emperor Constantine the Great. The "holy heads of St. Peter and St. Paul" are enclosed in two ornate reliquaries high above the main altar. After our visit, we'll see the Holy Stairs, believed to be the stairs that Christ walked in the Praetorium of Pontius Pilate. (The stairs must be climbed on one's knees). Independent lunch.

Free afternoon to explore Rome on your own.

Optional Scavi Tour (at additional cost; subject to confirmation): The Scavi, or Vatican Necropolis, is the underground excavation under St. Peter's Basilica. In 1939, Pope Pius XII ordered an excavation beneath the grotto of St. Peter's Basilica, where many popes are buried. Among the tombs of pagans and early Christians, far beneath the high altar of St. Peter's, excavators found a shrine amid the rubble. Most scholars concur that the small column is part of a second-century A.D. shrine built by Rome's small Christian community on the site where St. Peter was buried.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

DAY 7 Saturday, October 3: Return from Rome

After breakfast at our hotel, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. Arrive on the same day. (B)

Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in late 2026, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. After enrolling you will be sent information to apply online for ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.**

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$3,195.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$200 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Overseas round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package for the group tour dates. Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. **If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$895.00 will apply.** We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast daily, plus one (1) lunch at La Vittoria and two (2) dinners at Hotel Michelangelo.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend \$8.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$5.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for

local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person per day for housekeeping. **(For tips, USD is accepted however local currency is preferred).**
